1. All NEW students are strongly advised that that they should follow the pathway listed above under the “**July 2015 Intake**” and enrol in the courses as listed above if they wish to complete the programme within the stipulated 2 years (4 Semesters). The above list is based on SELC’s experience of monitoring returning students’ progression and also the workload expected in each course. It will enable students to better manage their progress and complete their

programme on time. **If any student skips a course in a semester, he/she would have to take it later when it is offered according to this list.**

2. Students must decide on their area of Specialisation (TESL or Educational Management) at the point of registering for the M Ed programme and will not be permitted to change specializations later.
3. Please take note that EED521/06 Educational Research Project can only be taken after students have **passed** their Specialisation courses and **enrolled** EED501/05 Research in Education. The course EED501/05 Research in Education has to be taken in the penultimate (second last) semester to help students prepare for their EED521/06 Educational Research Project and continue with the Project in the last semester.

ADVISORY TO ALL RETURNING STUDENTS OF M.Ed. PROGRAMME

All Returning students please take note of the following:

1. Students are strongly advised to enrol in courses listed in the **July 2015** semester (see Table 1 above).
2. From the January 2016 Semester EED520/05 Education Project will be offered under a new code and title as EED521/06 Educational Research Project. This is to be taken in the last semester after obtaining **a pass** for all the Specialisation courses and **having enrolled** in EED501/05 Research in Education.
3. Students are strongly advised to take EED501/05 Research in Education in their penultimate (second last) semester so that they can enrol for EED521/06 Educational Research Project in the middle of that semester, i.e. students planning to take the EED521/06 in the January semester must register for it in October of the previous semester. Similarly, students planning to take the EED521/06 in the July semester must register for it in April of the previous semester.
